<p>[<b>Note:</b> A 1939 WPA Survey of the cemetery lists Robert Byers as buried in the Centre Cemetery, death date as above, age 84, and stated that he was a soldier in the American Revolution. His name appears on the plaque in the church foyer of those from Centre Church that fought in the Revolution. However, we have not been able to locate his grave as many of the older tombstones are impossible to read. We have been unable to find any more information about him.]</p>

<p>*[<b>Note:</b> After the Battle of Ramsour's Mill on June 20, 1780, near Lincolnton, NC when Capt. Falls failed to return home, his wife, Isabella, rode 25 miles on horseback, accompanied by her negro cook. Finding her husband dead, Isabella borrowed a quilt to wrap him in and carried his body back to Centre Church Cemetery for burial. Three years later she married Hugh Torrence (1743-1816) and they are both buried in the Hopewell Presbyterian Church Cemetery in Huntersville, NC.]</p>

**\*\*[Note:** Adam Torrence, Sr. died on June 20, 1780 at the Battle of Ramsour's Mill near Lincolnton, NC and is buried there in an unmarked grave. However, he was a member of Centre Church and his wife, Ann Bonar Torrence, and several of his children are buried in Centre Cemetery.]
